

Milan | Genoa | Santa Margherita Ligue | Portofino |Cinque Terre | Nice | Sr. Tropez | Cannes | Milan Departure City: Milan or Genoa | End City: Nice or Milan

Day 01: MILAN TO GENOA (1H:45 MIN) by car

Arrived at Milan or Genoa airport, transfer to Genoa spent the day at leisure;

Discover Genoa, a port city and the capital of northwest Italy's Liguria region. See all the highlights of the beautiful coastal city and learn about the city's history and innovations. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore this fascinating city.

Day 02: RAPALLO(40 MIN) , SANTA MARGHERITA LIGURE (15 MIN) & PORTOFINO (15 MIN) by car

After Breakfast, depart to Rapallo, a charming coastal town on the Italian Riviera. Walk along the promenade, which is one of the best places to see the sights of the port city. Then Continue to Santa Margherita Ligure, one of the most attractive and charming in the Riviera. In the afternoon, travel to experience the beauty of Portofino, a seaside town, one of the most popular resort towns on the Italian Riviera. The town is known for its colorfully painted buildings that line the shore. The town is clustered around its half-moon-shaped harbor filled with yachts and fishing boats. Afterward, return to Genoa for the evening.

Day 03: PORTO VENERE (1H.40 MIN) & CINQUE TERRE by car

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to the medieval fishing village of Porto Venere, a Riviera jewel overlooking the Gulf of La Spezia. Continue by ferry (depending on weather conditions) to Cinque Terre. Cinque Terre is a rugged coastline on the Italian Riviera and consists of the five stunning hillside towns Monterosso, Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola, and Riomaggiore. In the afternoon, return to Genoa

Day 04: LAIGUEGLIA (1H.26 MIN) , FINALBORGO (40 MIN) , MONACO (1H.41 MIN) & NICE (32 MIN) by car

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the western coast of Liguria. Arrive in Laigueglia, a picturesque and tiny village of fishermen with charming beaches. Continue to Finalborgo, a medieval village at the bottom of the mountains where the Alps meet the Apennines. In the afternoon, continue on to Monaco. Pass by the Grimaldi Prince's Palace and stop for pictures in front of the cathedral where American actress Grace Kelly became Princess Grace is buried. Continue with a drive around Montecarlo, home of the Grand Prix and the Montecarlo Casino, where many movies are filmed. Continue on to Nice for the night.

Day 05: ST. TROPEZ (2H7 MIN), ST. RAPHAEL (1H 20 MIN) & ESTEREL COAST (33 MIN) by car

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy an excursion to the French Rivera. Visit St. Raphael and St. Tropez which are famous for their beautiful beaches. In the afternoon, travel back to Nice through the Esterel Coast, known for its beautiful panorama of cliffs and the beautiful sea.

Day 06: ST. PAUL DE VENCE (1H 8 MIN) , GRASSE (40 MIN) & CANNES (30 MIN) by car

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before heading to St Paul de Vance, a small medieval town with an artistic heritage. You'll see the remains of medieval walls and landscapes that influenced many artists. It's also home to the largest perfumeries in France. Afterward, stop in Cannes, home of the famous film festival and beautiful beaches. Then back to Nice.

Day 07: NICE, EZE (30 MIN), NOLI (1H 55 MIN) & MILAN (2H30 MIN) by car or(Option 02 get your flight back from Nice)

After breakfast, transfer to Eze, a beautiful medieval village on the hills between Nice and the Italian border. After visiting the old town of Eze, depart to Liguria with a stop for visiting Noli, a charming Italian Riviera fishing town. After the visit, continue to Milan.

Where to Stay in Genoa – 4 Top Areas and Accommodation Options

- Historic Center: This area is located in the heart of Genoa and is known for itscharming narrow streets, historic buildings, and vibrant atmosphere.
- Porto Antico: The Porto Antico (Old Port) area is a lively waterfront district with picturesque views
- Boccadasse: If you prefer a more relaxed and picturesque setting, consider staying in Boccadasse.
- Nervi: Nervi is a peaceful neighborhood located to the east of Genoa

<u>Starhotels President 4*</u> Located opposite the Genoa Brignole train and metro stations, Starhotels President is near the city's shopping district. It offers free WiFi throughout, modern rooms with air conditioning.

Novotel Genoa City 4*Located just off the A7 motorway, Genova City Novotel is a 10-minute drive from the city center. Alternatively, you can catch a bus to Genoa's Aquarium right outside the hotel.

<u>NH Genoa Centro 4*</u>Piazza de Ferrari and the De Ferrari Metro Station are a 5-minute walk from NH Genova Centro. Carlo Felice Opera House is 600 meters away, and buses going to the Brignole Train Station stop 50 meters from the hotel.

Where to Stay in Nice, France – 4 Top Areas and Accommodation Options

- Old Town (Vieux Nice)
- Promenade des Anglais.
- Gambetta.
- Le Port.

<u>Hotel Le Negresco 5*</u> overlooks the beach and the Promenade des Anglais in Nice, The hotel is a 15-minute walk from Nice's Old Town and Nice-Ville Train Station. Nice Côte d'Azur Airport is just 5 km from the hotel.

Best Western Plus Hôtel Massena Nice 4* In the heart of Nice, just 200 meters from the beach. The property is with a 5-minute walk from Nice's Old Town and Massena Tram Stop.

<u>Hotel Apollinaire 4*</u> Located in Nice city center, 1 km from the beach and the Promenade des Anglais, Hotel Apollinaire offers free WiFi access and a 24-hour front desk. This property is 650 meters from Place Massena and from Promenade du Paillon Park.

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
