To reach Naples, Italy there are several transportation options available including connection flights, and it can be combined with Rome so can reach it by car (around H 30 MIN) or Train.

It's highly recommended to base yourself in Sorrento and use it as a central hub for exploration. Sorrento, with its convenient location and excellent transportation connections, allows for easy access to both the Amalfi Coast and the vibrant city of Naples.

Hotel Continental 4* *The property is just a 10-minute walk from the main square, Piazza Tasso and Sorrento Train Station, where guests can catch trains to Naples.*

Hotel Bristol 4* *Staying at the Bristol Hotel means you are away from the crowds yet just a 10-minute walk to the center.*
