Day 01: Prague

Arrived at the airport, transfer to hotel, Afternoon explore Prague the Baroque jewel of Europe start from the Old Town Square, then try another side of the city on a river cruise.

Day 02: Prague

Day 05: Vienna – Budapest

After Breakfast, transfer to Train Station to get your train to Budapest. Transfer to hotel.

Day 06: Budapest

Budapest, is known as the Pearl of the Danube, One of the best ways of seeing this unique location is by taking a river cruise, After a morning of activity, you'll relax over lunch at Buda Palace, and then have a chance to look at the exhibitions in the Budapest History Museum and Hungarian National Gallery, or do a spot of souvenir shopping. next you'll explore both sides of the city on a cultural and historic tour. Highlights on the Buda side of the Danube include the towered terrace of Fisherman's Bastion, the medieval Matthias Church and a walk up to the summit of Gellért Hill for panoramic views. While over in Pest the sights include the expansive Heroes' Square and Hungary's dramatic riverside Parliament Building. In the evening, you can choose to round off an eventful day with an optional dinner in the heart of Budapest, where you can sample traditional dishes such as goose liver, goulash, duck leg and local wine, accompanied by Hungarian folkdance and music.

Where to Stay in Prague – Area and Accommodation Options

Prague 1 (Old Town): This is the historic heart of the city, known for its stunning architecture, cobblestone streets, and iconic landmarks like the Astronomical Clock and Charles Bridge. Staying in Prague 1 will give you easy access to major attractions, restaurants, and shops, but keep in mind that it can be quite busy and touristy.

<u>Grandium Hotel Prague5*</u> is situated in the heart of Prague, just around the corner from Wenceslas Square.

The 987 Prague Hotel 4^{*} is situated within a 10 to 15-minute walk of all major historical attractions, including Wenceslas Square, Old Town Square, and Charles Bridge.

Hotel Garden Court 4^{*} Old Town Square is a 12-minute walk from the accommodation, while Wenceslas Square is 700 meters away.

Where to Stay in Vienna – Area and Accommodation Options

Innere Stadt (City Center): The Innere Stadt is Vienna's historic core and UNESCO World Heritage site. It is home to many of the city's iconic landmarks, including St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Hofburg Palace, and the State Opera House. Staying in the city center allows for easy access to major attractions, shopping streets like Kärntner Strasse, and a plethora of cafes and restaurants.

Palais Elegance Wien4*

Conveniently located in the centre of Vienna, Palais Elegance Wien is within 600 metres of Austrian National Library and 200 metres of Albertina Museum.

Ruby Lissi Hotel 4*

Located in Vienna's first district and set in a historic building dating back to the 18th century, within walking distance of the Schwedenplatz and St. Stephan's Cathedral,

District V (Belváros-Lipótváros): This is the city's historic center and the most central district. It is known for its beautiful architecture, pedestrian-friendly streets, and proximity to major landmarks such as the Hungarian Parliament, St. Stephen's Basilica, and the Chain Bridge. District V offers a wide range of hotels, restaurants, and shops, and it is a great choice for those who want to be in the heart of the city.

Alice Hotel 4*:

Alice Hotel is situated in the centre of Budapest, less than 1 km from House of Terror. Located around 1.9 km from Keleti Pályaudvar Metro Station, the hotel with free WiFi is also 1.8 km away from Hungarian State Opera. The property is allergy-free and is set 500 metres from Heroes' Square.

Central Basilica 4*:

Hotel Central Basilica is situated in the heart of Budapest in a pedestrian steet, only 50 metres from St Stephen's Basilica.
